

All programs meet at the Parkview Education Center at 1919 W. Cook Road.



HOW TO APPLY ELIGIBILITY * 1ST YEAR ENROLLMENT * 2ND YEAR ENROLLMENT

Eligibility

Students that are qualified to apply for a program at the FWCS Career Academy, demonstrate:

- •Consistently good attendance
- ·Low number of tardies, unexcused, and truant absences
- •Average to above average grades in current and previous core classes like English, Math, and Social Studies
- •Average to above average scores on assessments like PSAT, SAT, ACT, State Assessments, etc.
- •Ability to be a respectful and responsible school citizen. Consistent exhibition of aggressive behaviors, defiant nature, dangerous behaviors, and/or irresponsible actions will disqualify a student.



Application

Students interested in applying for their 1st Year at the FWCS Career Academy or interested in applying for their 2nd year at FWCS Career Academy in a different program should:

•Complete the regular or white 2021-2022 application form (there is no blue application this year) •Student completes the personal information section

•Meet with your guidance counselor to discuss your career choices and scheduling options

•Submit application to your guidance counselor

Students interested in applying for admission into the 2nd year at FWCS Career Academy in the same program of study, should:

- •Complete the yellow application
- •Meet with instructor to determine if they are recommended for a second year
- •If recommended, instructor will sign the application and return to the student
- •Student should complete the personal information section and select the appropriate program and section
- •Submit application to your guidance counselor
