2023-2024 Actual Tuition Costs

•Parish Rate = \$9,373

•Non-Parish Rate = \$10,873

Note: Pastor determines if a family is an active parishioner

Each student is required to have a laptop. Please do not purchase your laptop until the system requirements have been finalized and communicated.



Freshmen/Transfer Students will have a one-time tech fee of \$130 added to tuition bill.

What is Tuition Assistance?

- Approximately 70% of our families receive some form of tuition assistance
- Over \$3.0 million is awarded each year:
 - Tuition Assistance
 - Indiana School Choice Scholarships
 - SGO Award
 - Merit-based Scholarships
 - Need-based Scholarships





- I. Recommended Deadline: April 15th
- 2. Fee: \$40 non-refundable application fee per family
- 3. Families with children attending multiple schools complete one application, include all students and all schools for which parents are paying tuition
 - Diocese can follow the status of an application through an online tracking system
 - Analysis and financial reports by FACTS are provided online to the Diocese
- 4. FACTS application is required for:
 - Tuition Assistance Grants
 - Bishop Dwenger Scholarships (<u>not</u> School Choice)
 - SGO Award

How Much Assistance Will I Receive?

- FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment calculates need
- Bishop Dwenger receives a confidential report outlining your current financial status, based on the information obtained from your FACTS application
- Once the applications are processed, assistance is awarded based on need and availability of funds
- Tuition assistance grants are awarded based on individual family need in direct proportion to other families applying for aid that year
- A family can still receive additional assistance even if a scholarship is awarded, including School Choice Scholarship and SGO Award

How Will I Know if My Family Receives Tuition Assistance?

FACTS Grant & Aid applications are reviewed by the Principal and Business Manager

- You may be contacted by the Business Office or Principal for additional information
- Tuition bills will be sent in July, and preliminary scholarship award notices will be available on Verification Day, if not before
- Amounts will be finalized in September and accounts will be adjusted at that time
- Tuition Assistance may be adjusted based on scholarships received



Indiana Choice Scholarship

Legislative changes related to the School Choice program went into effect on June 29, 2023:

- 1. The eligibility pathways/tracks have been removed
- 2. Financial eligibility increased from 300% to 400% of Free and Reduced Lunch eligibility

For a family to qualify for School Choice, there are only two factors to consider:

- I. Indiana Residency
- 2. Total Household Income
 - The income limits will be published on our website once the state publishes the official income limits for the 24-25 program year

SGO

(Scholarship Granting Organization)

The SGO award is granted by a school to students whose families meet the required income guidelines.

- I. Applications for an SGO award are processed through FACTS. Once your application is verified, you are then considered for an SGO award
- 2. A student may receive one SGO award each year
- 3. Awards are approved in October, with a second round of determinations in January
- 4. Award amounts vary in size based upon available funds; minimum award is \$500

Scholarship 101

- A wide variety of Dwenger scholarships are available, with each having its own criteria
- To be eligible for a Dwenger scholarship award, you must also complete the FACTS Management Grant & Aid form (FACTS not needed for Choice Scholarship)
- Students must complete the online application, available at bishopdwenger.com, under "Admissions" and "Tuition & Assistance"

Scholarship 101

- The Bishop Dwenger Merit Scholarship is the only merit-based scholarship; awards are allocated solely on results of Merit Exam, administered in December of 8th grade year
- All other Dwenger Scholarships are based on financial need and scholastic ability



Scholarship Application - Online

- Online scholarship & FACTS applications are due by April 15th
- Application must be completed in its entirety by the student
- Be sure to upload a Power School print out of current grades or a copy of your child's report card
- One letter of recommendation by a teacher, priest, coach, or administrator (non-family) is required
- Essay required

Scholarship Application Process

- Applications are reviewed by the scholarship committee in the summer
- Committee recommendations are made based on quality of application

Award is then allocated based on FACTS information and quality of application

 Notification of award to the family will be finalized in July; preliminary award letters will be available on Verification Day

Future Scholarships



- A new FACTS application must be completed each year by the <u>parent</u>
- A new scholarship application and essay must be completed <u>each year</u> by the <u>student</u>
- Some scholarships renew based on student performance see each individual scholarship for details on the BD website under "Admissions" and "Tuition & Assistance"

Paying Your Tuition

ALL families are required to enroll in a FACTS Payment Plan during enrollment & application

- FACTS Payment Plan Options:
 - Full Amount due by August 1st
 - Semi-Annual August 1st and December 1st (no fee)
 - Semi-Annual due August & February (\$30 FACTS fee)
 - Ten (10) monthly payments (August-May) (\$80 FACTS fee)
- Payment Types available through FACTS:
 - Auto-Debit from checking or savings account on the 5th or 20th of each month
 - Credit or Debit Card, plus convenience fee

Free or Reduced-Price Meals

- To apply for free or reduced-price meals, complete the form on BD website under "Policy/Forms" located in the Quick Links section of the website; 2023-2024 application will be available after July Ist
- Applications should be sent to the attention of Susan Schenkel, Business Manager, by August 1st to be in effect the first day of school
- Families with children attending multiple schools will need to complete an application with <u>each</u> school
