



AMP LAB PROGRAM OPTIONS





Amp Lab is a half-day program for Juniors and Seniors that offers four unique program options for students. All programs focus on helping students develop an entrepreneurial spirit and engage in innovative learning experiences. Amp Lab helps students build a portfolio by solving real problems with real people across all career clusters. Students can attend either in the morning or in the afternoon. The morning session runs from 7:40 - 10:30 am and the afternoon session runs from 11:10 - 2:00 pm. Students must provide their own transportation.

All Amp Lab programs are rooted in the Entrepreneurship Pathway and are aligned to both the graduation pathways and the new diploma seals. The pathway includes the following classes:

- Students in their first year take the following classes currently (1 credit each per semester):
 - 7154, Principles of Entrepreneurship
 - 7147, New Venture Development
 - 7148, Entrepreneurial Operations
- Students that return for a 2nd year, that the following class (3 credits per semester):
 - 7201, Small Business Operations Capstone

Dual Credit: Students that are eligible (having a 2.0 GPA or higher), are able to earn up to 18 dual credits from Indiana Tech in business management, entrepreneurship, marketing, and finance. The Pearl Arts Innovation Institute also has an articulation agreement with Saint Francis' Music Technology program.

The following four program options are available to students and are listed in order from largest to smallest capacity:

Amp Lab at Electric Works, Entrepreneurship & Innovation Across All Industries	
	Seats Available: 400 Location: Electric Works Students engage in embedded work-based learning, start-up creation, and off-site immersion experiences across all career clusters. Through intrapreneurship and entrepreneurship, students work with hundreds of industry professionals to solve real problems. Students can choose to go deep in one industry or gain a breadth of experiences across multiple industries.
Pearl Arts Innovation Institute, Music Industry Entrepreneurship	
	Seats Available: 50 Location: Pearl Street Arts Center At the Pearl Arts Innovation Institute, students are immersed in an active creative arts community while pursuing their interest in music industry entrepreneurship. From musicians to audio engineers to songwriters to music business to arts management, students at the Innovation Institute prepare for entering the music economy after graduation.
Amp Lab at The REFINERY, Robotics Entrepreneurship	
	Seats Available: 15-20 Location: Electric Works At Amp Lab at The REFINERY, students run an actual start-up that supports the FIRST robotics team in NE Indiana. In partnership with BioNanomics, students at The REFINERY run the day-to-day operations of the robotics center. Students engage in areas of robotics, fabrication, management, marketing, and outreach.
3Rivers FCU Internship Program, Banking & Finance Immersion	
	Seats Available: 5-10 Location: Multiple Students are exposed to all aspects of the banking and finance industry within 3Rivers Federal Credit Union. Students learn customer service, personal banking, business banking, lending, financial technology, and operations across various departments of 3Rivers. Students spend a portion of their week at a 3Rivers location and a portion of their week at Amp Lab at Electric Works.
