HOW TO become a SAINT

GATHER

Birth Certificate (copy of state-issued form)

Current grades (be sure to include ALL subjects; a phone's screenshot of PowerSchool usually does not capture all subjects). A current report card is acceptable.

Application Deadline is January 15. Any applications submitted after this date could be subject to a wait list. Applications submitted by this date will be on track for February scheduling.

Choice of FACTS tuition payment plan. The application will not be considered final until this is completed. You will actually complete the application, receive an email and use the link in the email to select a plan.

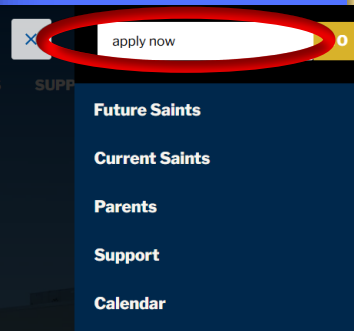

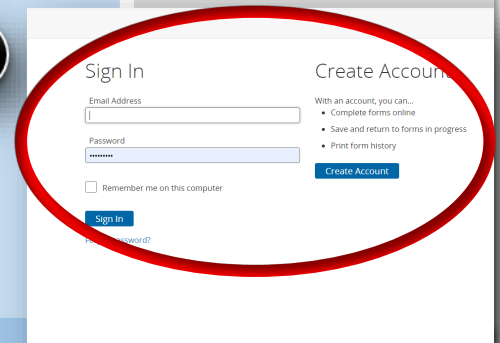
