- Collaborate with other members of the staff in planning instructional goals, objectives, and methods
- Seek the cooperation and assistance of parents through oral or written communication
- Make provisions for being available to students and parents for education-related purposes when required or requested to do so under reasonable terms
- Demonstrate punctuality and responsibility in performing all duties and activities as assigned
- Participate in professional development programs as assigned by the School Administration
- Willingly perform other related duties as required/assigned
