Essential Responsibilities

Instruction and Curriculum

- Plan and deliver engaging lessons aligned with Indiana Academic Standards and departmental/diocesan curriculum frameworks.
- Teach assigned English courses, based on qualifications and departmental needs.
 - This position is for Academic English Literature, Honors English Literature, Digital Media, Expository Writing, and if qualified, dual credit Introduction to Literature.
- Develop students' reading comprehension, analytical thinking, writing proficiency, and communication skills.
- Utilize a variety of instructional strategies and educational technologies to meet diverse student learning needs.
 - Bishop Dwenger is a 1:1 school utilizing a blended learning teaching approach.
- Assess student learning through formative and summative assessments and provide timely, meaningful feedback.
- Use data to drive instruction and growth in students. (Local and standardized assessment data.)
- Maintain accurate and current records of attendance, grades, and student progress.

Student Development

- Foster a classroom environment that promotes academic excellence, respect, responsibility, and student engagement.
- Encourage students to grow intellectually, morally, spiritually, and socially.
- Communicate effectively with students, parents, counselors, and administrators regarding student progress and concerns.
- Provide appropriate academic support and intervention for struggling learners.

- Commitment to the mission and values of Catholic education.
- Active, registered Catholic is preferred.
