- Develop lesson plans aligned with Indiana Academic Standards and Bishop Dwenger curriculum frameworks
- Incorporate laboratory investigations, inquiry-based learning, and hands-on experimentation
- Integrate technology and real-world scientific applications into instruction utilizing the schools 1:1 blended learning model utilizing Canvas
- Assess student progress using a variety of formative and summative methods
- Maintain accurate and timely grade records in the school’s system

#### **Faith & Ethical Integration**

- Encourage thoughtful dialogue regarding the relationship between faith and science
- Promote ethical reflection on scientific issues in light of Catholic social teaching
- Foster a classroom culture that respects the dignity of every person
