Financial Aid – 2026-27 FAFSA

Families of seniors attending college next year should plan to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) **2026-27** to secure need-based aid. Need-based financial aid includes loans, grants, scholarships, and work-based study. The filing window for the **2026-27 FAFSA** in Indiana is October 1, 2025 - April 15, 2026. Please note that colleges/universities typically have an earlier deadline. It is recommended that FAFSA be completed as early as possible. The FAFSA is submitted online and is available [here](#) and requires parent and student tax information from 2024. To complete a **2026-27 FAFSA**, you will need a student and a parent FSA ID, one for each. Create these [here](#). Once you have your FSA IDs you are ready to complete FAFSA [here](#).

PFW FAFSA Completion Event: On Friday, October 17, PFW will offer community support to families completing the 2026-27 FAFSA, regardless of which college the student plans to attend. College Goal Sunday: College Goal Sunday is a state-wide initiative to help families complete the 2026-27 FAFSA. One-on-one help is provided, and Spanish speaking experts will be available. College Goal Sunday will be held on Sunday, November 9 at Ivy Tech from 2:00-4:00. Families are asked to take 2024 tax return forms, FSA IDs, and any other relevant information with them.

Attention students and families:

On **Wednesday, October 15th**, our school will be administering the **PSAT 8/9** and **PSAT/NMSQT**:

- All Freshmen will take the **PSAT 8/9**
- All Sophomores and Juniors will take the **PSAT/NMSQT**

Students in grades 9–11 should bring the following items to school on test day:

- A **fully charged computer**
- Their **charging cord**
- An **optional bottle of water**
- A **calculator**

No additional items will be permitted in the testing rooms. This includes, but is not limited to:

- NO Cell phones
- NO Smartwatches
- NO AirPods or other earbuds
- NO Computer bags or backpacks

Testing room assignments will be posted during the **first week of October**, organized by

students' English classes. Meanwhile, **Seniors** will participate in a **College & Career Exploration Day** on the same date—October 15.
