Those pilgrims who are **16-17** years old as of July 28, 2023. Those who are 18 as of July 28, 2023 will only be considered youth pilgrims if they will be in high school in 2023-2024. Youth pilgrims must be 16 years old by July 28, 2023 in order to participate.

*Young Adult Pilgrims

Those pilgrims who are 18-35 years old as of July 28, 2023, **AND** who will have graduated high school in 2023 or before, will be considered young adult pilgrims. Young adult pilgrims CANNOT be 36 years old or older as of July 28, 2023, and still participate unless attending as a Chaperone for Youth Pilgrims, or as a Priest, Religious, or Seminarian.
