As you consider your future high school, please prayerfully contemplate the following:



The Mission of Bishop Dwenger is based upon our **Four Pillars: Spirituality, Academics, Active Life, and Life of Service**. Bishop Dwenger is first and foremost a Catholic diocesan high school. We strive to bring Christ into the lives of our students in various ways throughout each day, activity, and lesson taught.

Our Catholic identity is prominent throughout the building as our hallways, classrooms, and offices are adorned with murals and pictures that represent our Faith. Students model our Catholic teachings in their actions toward classmates and staff. Each class begins with a prayer, as do our morning and afternoon announcements. In fact, we begin our home athletic events by calling upon God to be present with us! As a school family, we join together monthly for an All-School Mass. During each lunch period, a decade of the rosary can be heard echoing from the chapel as students gather in prayer for various intentions. Likewise, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered weekly during the lunch hour.


