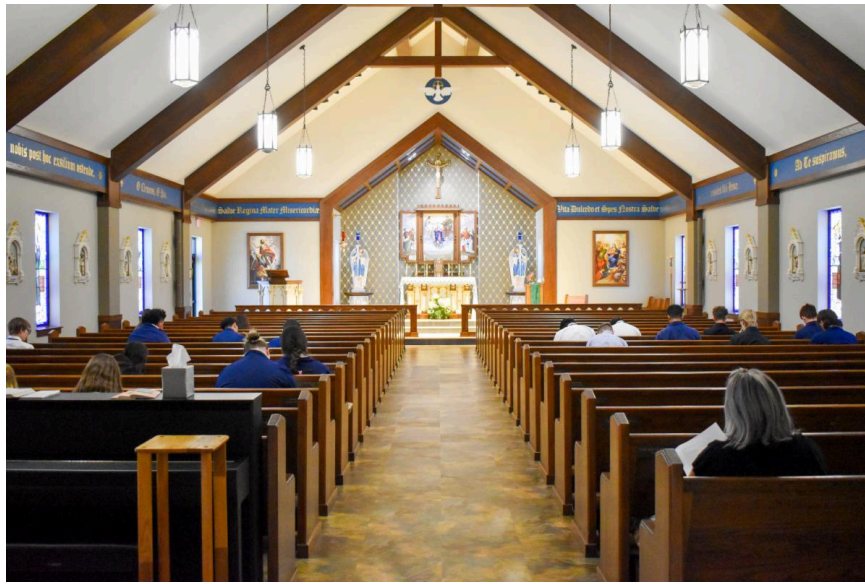


Religious Life
